## News From Class 2

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I hope you all had a lovely half term: our first week back has certainly seemed to fly by! In maths this week the children have been problem solving and reasoning. They have had to use all of their maths skills to work their way through various problems which for some they have had to explain how they got to answer or explain why statements were correct or incorrect. In Science as part of our work on adaptation, the children this week had to invent their own creature that would be able to survive in the Antarctic. They thought carefully about what their animal would need to be able to survive using the information that they had already learnt. For our English this work this week, we have combined it with our topic on Antarctica and have been researching about different aspects of Antarctica. They are now in the process of using the information that they have collected to write a non-chronological report about their chosen aspect. On Wednesday afternoon, we were joined by Class 1 and as part of our continuing work on British Values we thought carefully about what they would like the new government to change, which we are planning on sending to the Houses of Parliament.

Yesterday, I sent home a new reading record and a bookmark with the children. The bookmark is for the children to keep track of which page they are up to rather than writing it down and then if you continue to comment/sign when you have listened to them read or discussed their book with them as usual in their reading record. In the front of the book, there is a sheet that gives them a choice of activities to do once they have read their book to help show their understanding of what they have read.

## News From Class 1

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I hope that you all had a lovely half term, this first week back has been as busy as ever in class one and it was lovely to hear all about your holiday activities on Monday. The children have been updating their bean diaries this week and we all planted our beans outside to allow them to grow further. In maths we are continuing to look at multiplication and division. This half term I will be looking at mini-beasts with the children. We have begun by finding a range of non-fiction books on insects and bugs and the children had fun leafing through them to find interesting facts. We looked at the features of non-fiction texts and will be following on by researching mini-beasts to help us create our own non-fiction class book. On Wednesday we came together with Class 2 to look at British Values by thinking about the election and things which the children would like the new government to change. The children worked really hard and came up with some lovely ideas which we plan to send to the Houses of Parliament.


