## News From Class 2

---

We have had yet again another busy week and time just seems to be flying by! In English this week we have been working on our editing skills. The children have been busy re-drafting and editing their non-chronological reports which we started last week. They looked carefully to see how they could improve their sentences making sure that they used a wide range of punctuation and conjunctions to improve the quality of their sentences. In maths year 5 and 6 have been working on negative numbers whilst year 3 and 4 have been solving problems around money and giving change. In our science work this week, the children have been looking at food chains; the children then created their own food chain for Antarctica. As part of our geography topic this week, we looked at reasons why the ice caps are melting and how the Earth is effected by climate change, which we will explore more about next week.

After weeks of training, it was finally time to put to test our new found tag rugby skills. The children all played exceptionally well and were a credit to the school. One of the coaches involved with the children's training was extremely impressed with how much their skills had come on and how enthusiastically all our children played! A special well done to Reuben and Kitty who scored most of the team's try's.

It has been another busy week in class one this week . The warmer weather has meant we have been able to get outside more and the children are re-discovering our outdoor area and putting it to good use. We are looking at data handling in maths and have linked this to our Gardeners world topic by going on a mini-beast hunt. The children designed their own tally charts and then used them to collect data on mini-beasts. We will use all the information we collected to create bar charts and graphs over the next couple of weeks. Mrs Sandoe is looking at poetry and the children composed their own little rhymes which they learnt and performed for the rest of the class. I am continuing to look into non fiction texts and the children have been busy finding and labelling key features of information books.

The Year Two children have had a fantastic woodland day at Parceval hall and they both came back buzzing with all the exciting things they got to do. Mrs Braithwaite said they were beautifully behaved and a pleasure to take. Well Done Year 2!


