A Message from the Friends Committee

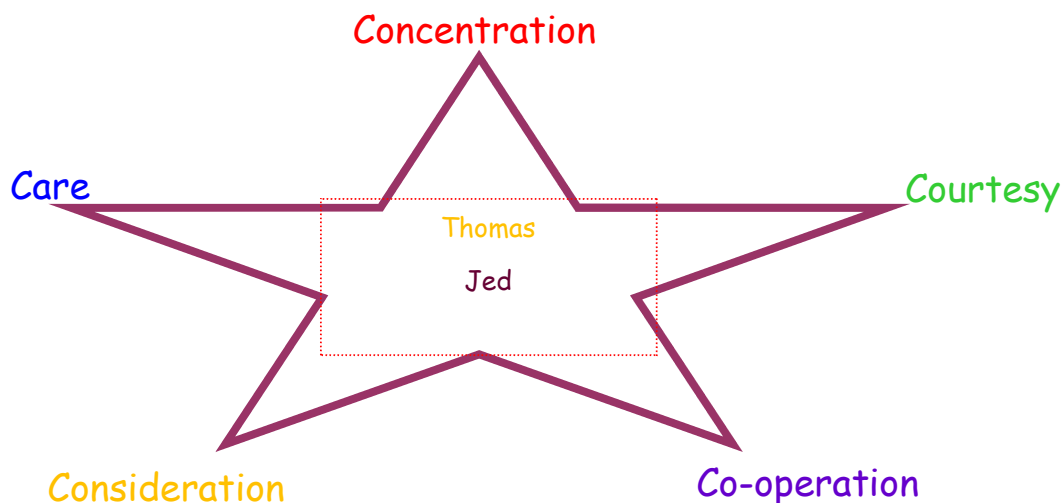
