News From Class 2

Welcome back—I Hope you have all had a lovely half term holiday. This week, the children have been dreaming of travelling somewhere for a holiday and trying to persuade me to go with them. They have spent the week looking at persuasive features of writing and today they have written their draft copy of the persuasive holiday leaflet. In maths, the children have been looking at angles—measuring them and finding the value of the missing angles. In art, the children looked at Molas which originate from Panama. This textile art was developed when Kuna women had access to store bought yard goods. The children looked very closely at the different designs and have now planned out their own design that they will make next week. In science this week the children have been looking at the different properties of materials. They will be using the information that they collected to help them make predictions about materials that they will carry out this term.

The children should have brought home their new KIRF targets for this term and spellings along with Maths and grammar homework. Please could homework and KIRFs book be returned by Thursday, so that I can get them ready to send out again next Friday. Thank you.

News From Class 1

It has been lovely to hear about all the things the children did over half term this week we enjoyed reading all about your adventures from the children's journal writing. This week they were challenged to include days of the week when writing and we have some super pieces which the children worked really hard on. This week we have started to look at the key features of non fiction texts, the children ordered books depending on how good they felt they were and began to research a little bit about penguins. In maths we have looked at number bonds to 100 and subtraction on a number line whilst Mrs Sandoe has begun to investigate money with the children.

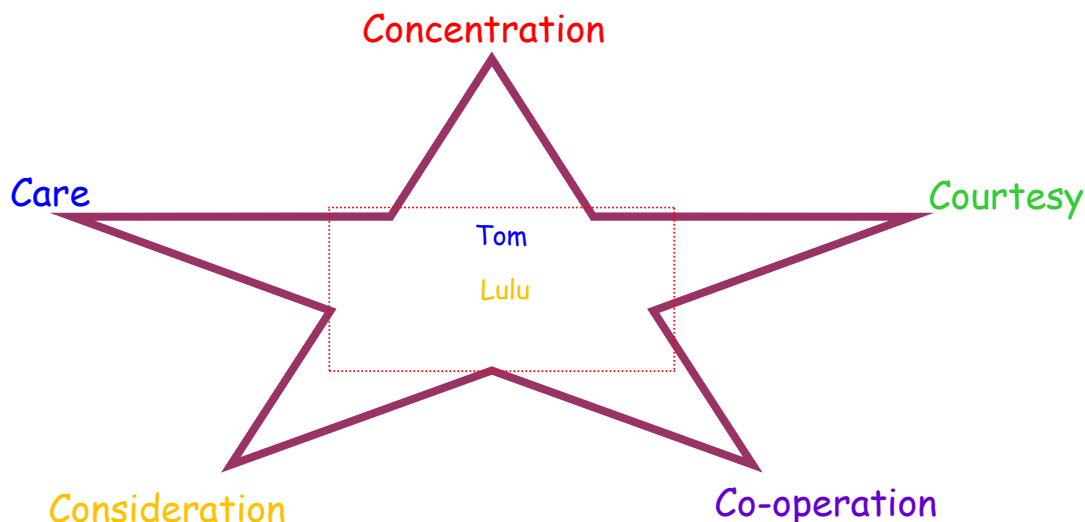
