



## **Sports and PE funding**

From 2016-2017, the school will receive a new Sports and PE fund from the Government of £8000 plus £5 per child, totaling £8,130

This money is being used to improve our sports provision through:

- purchasing sports/swimming facilities and staff at Upper Wharfedale School weekly for KS2 pupils - £2,760
- Enabling the running/participation of sporting competitions at cluster, local and regional levels (Sainsbury's award) - staffing (TA, HLTA and Rugby coach) and participation - £1,800
- funding a program of cluster school's sports activities, including training and support for our class teachers and HLTA- £2,400
- providing after school sports clubs, for Yr2-Yr6, of Cheer leading, Dodge ball and multi- skills, staffing on walks in the environment etc. £896
- providing additional new sports and outdoor equipment for clubs etc. and training for staff- £300

## **Impact 2015-16 and 2016-17**

Sainsbury's Bronze award received. (Not silver as we can't do in school matches.)

### **In school data**

- *47% of pupils in Yrs 2-6 attend a sports club in a year*
- *100% of KS 2 have represented the school in a sports competition throughout the year.*
  - *The Year 5 & 6 Tag Rugby team got through to the area final*
  - *The Year 5 & 6 Netball team came second in the area final*
  - *Year 5 & 6 Rounder team came second in the Cluster event*
  - *Year 5 & 6 Cricket team came second in the Cluster event*
  - *Year 5 & 6 joint football team with Cracoe came second in the Cluster event.*
  - *The Year 3 & 4 joint Tag Rugby team with Cracoe played in the Cluster event.*
- *100% of pupils in KS2 can swim.*

### **North Yorkshire's Children' and Young People's Health and Wellbeing survey 2016**

- *100 % of children enjoy Physical activity 72% enjoying it quite a lot or more.*
- *84% say they do 5 or more hours of physical activity per week with 71% saying that they had exercised 5 or more times in the previous week.*
